- Tools are too cold to handle; fluids freeze.

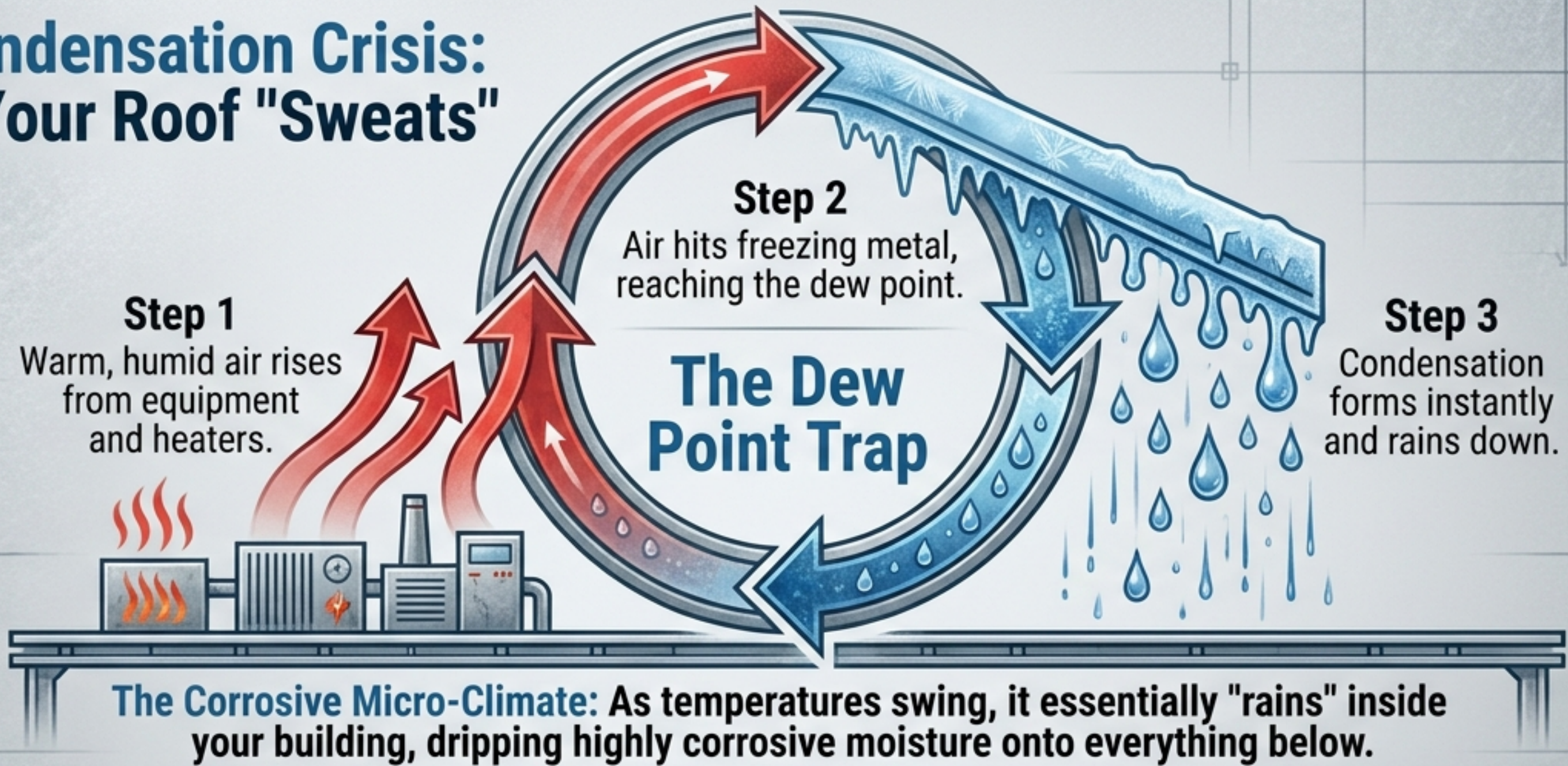
The Summer Bake

Accelerated rust and electrical failure.

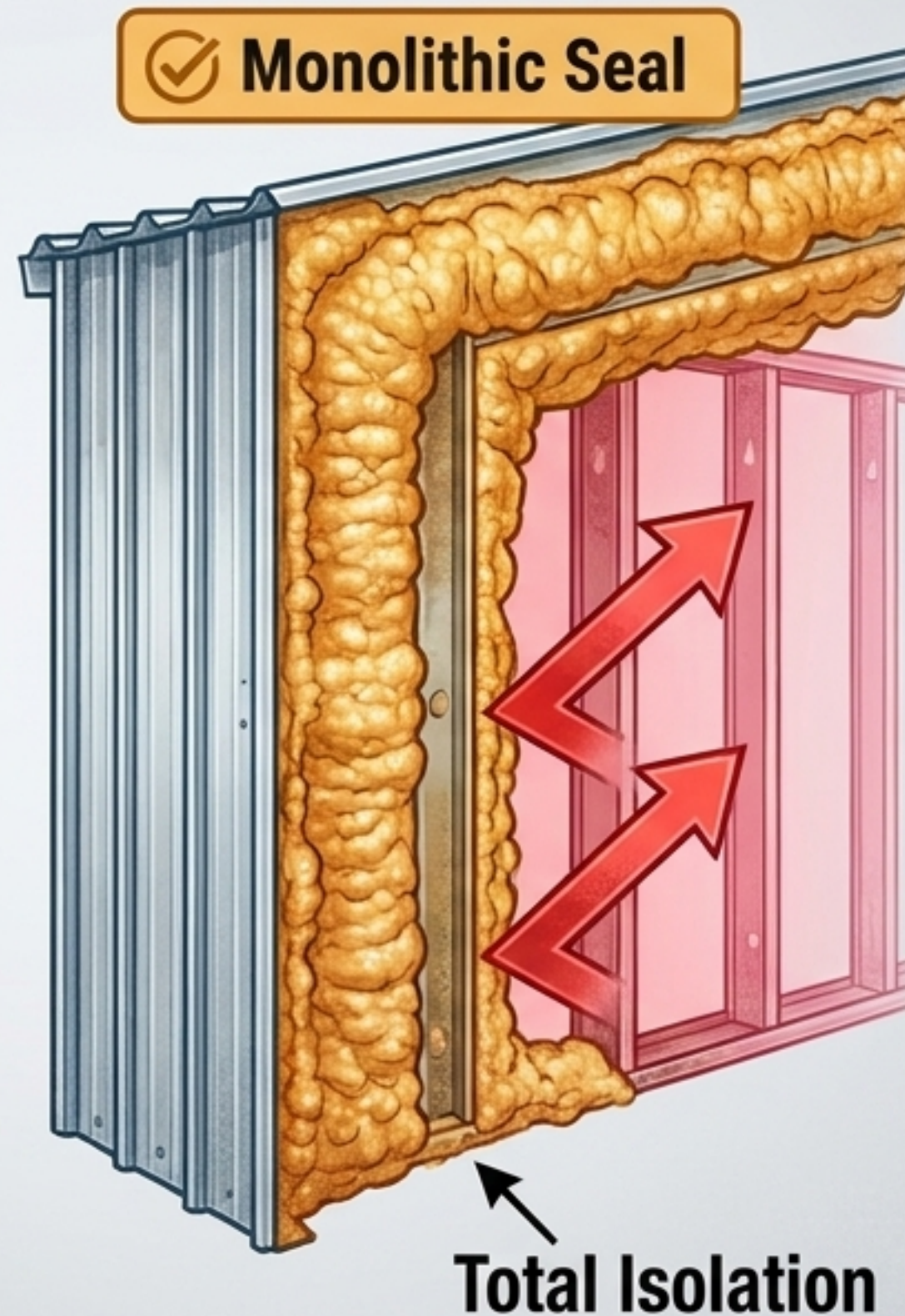
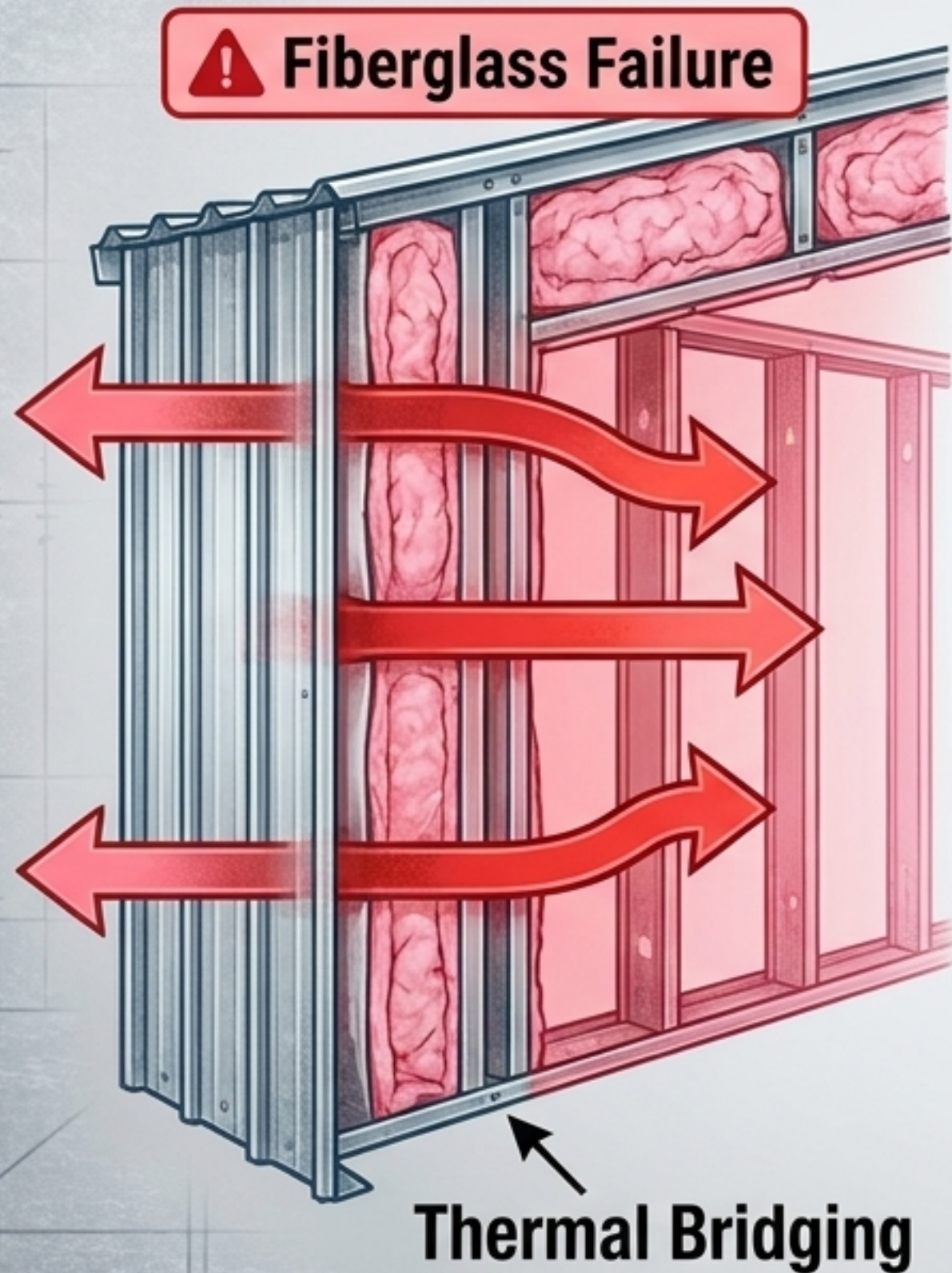


Vehicles

The Fatal Flaw of Fiberglass: Thermal Bridging



What is Thermal Bridging?

Steel is a massive conductor. Metal studs and purlins act as "highways," actively pulling heat directly out of your building.

Why Batts Fail

Traditional fiberglass or foam board sits between the poles. The highly conductive metal skeleton remains fully exposed to the elements.

The Result

Up to a 40% loss in overall insulating performance, creating continuous cold spots where condensation aggressively forms.

Seamless Application

Applied as a liquid, it expands 30x to fill every single corrugation, gap, and fastener hole.

100% Vapor Barrier

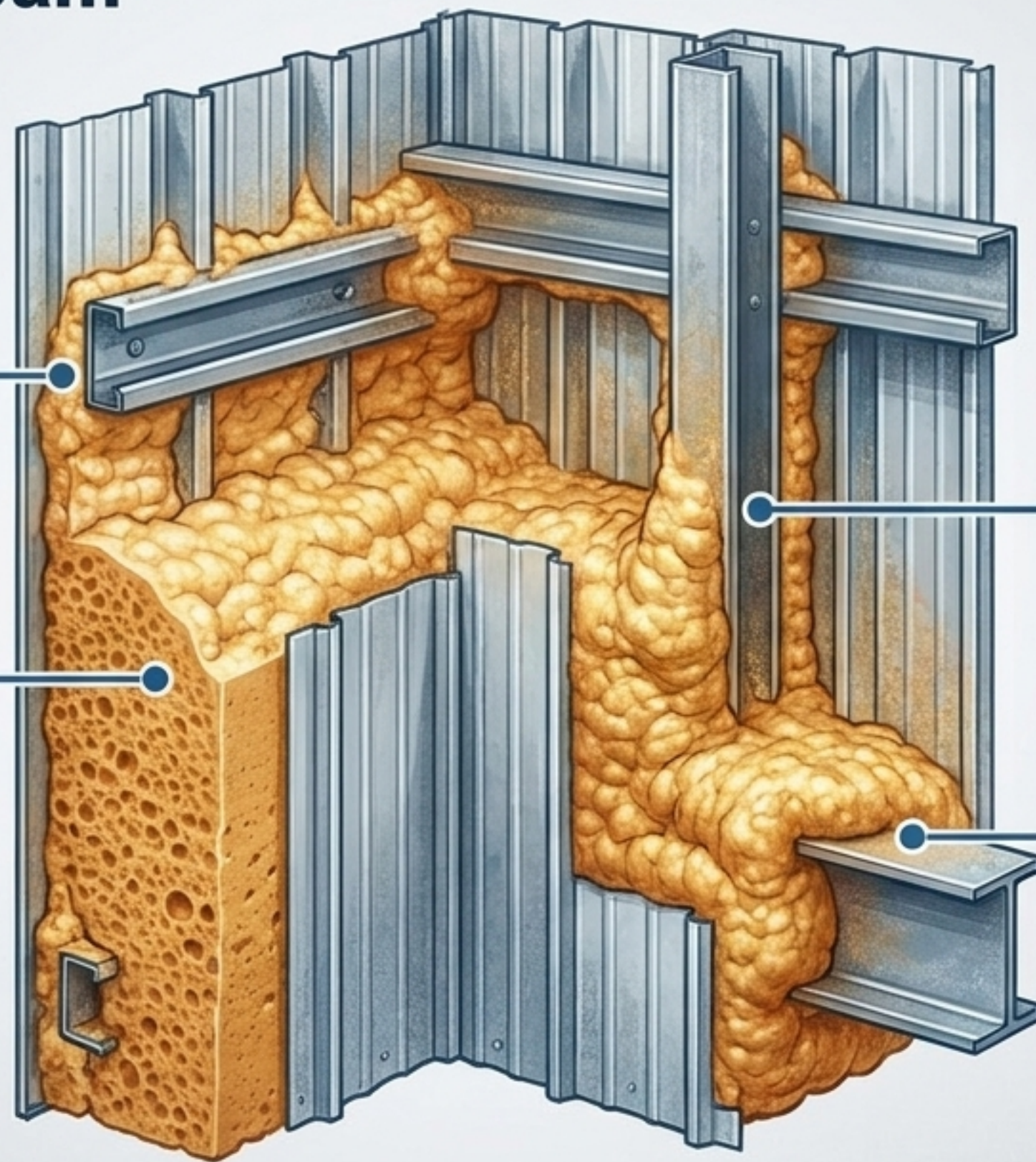
Dense closed-cell foam halts moisture transmission entirely, killing the “sweating roof” crisis permanently.

Cures rock-hard. Glues the entire building together, adding up to 250% racking strength against high winds.

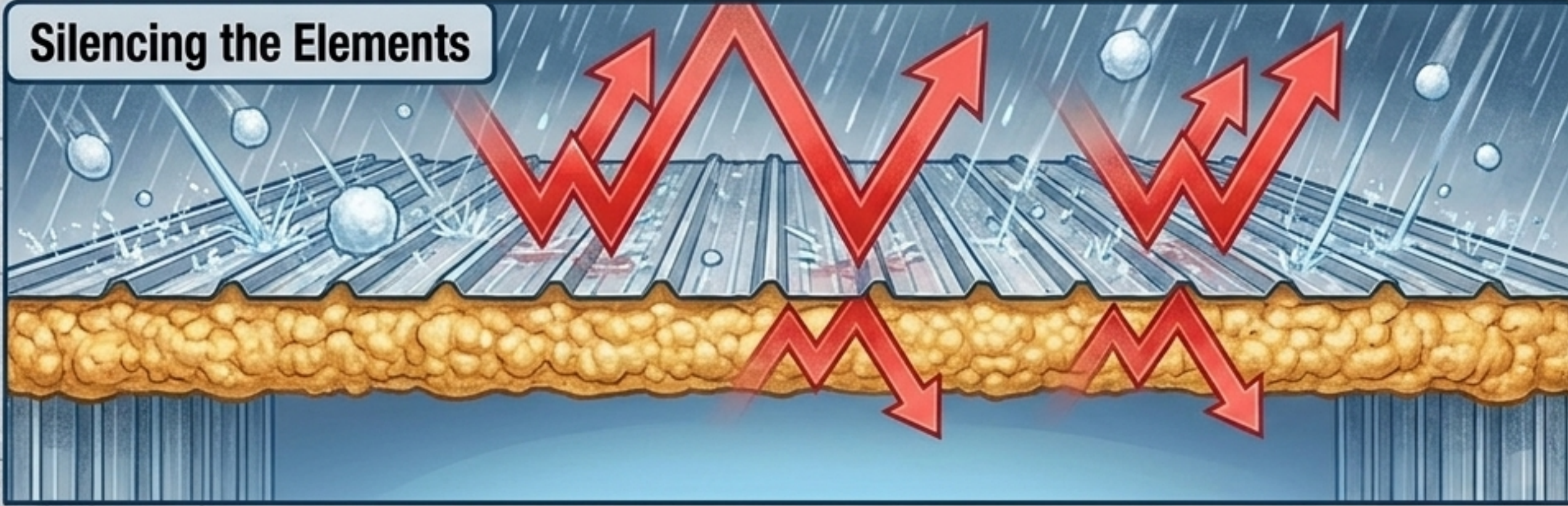

Completely isolates the interior from the exterior metal—eliminating thermal bridging forever.

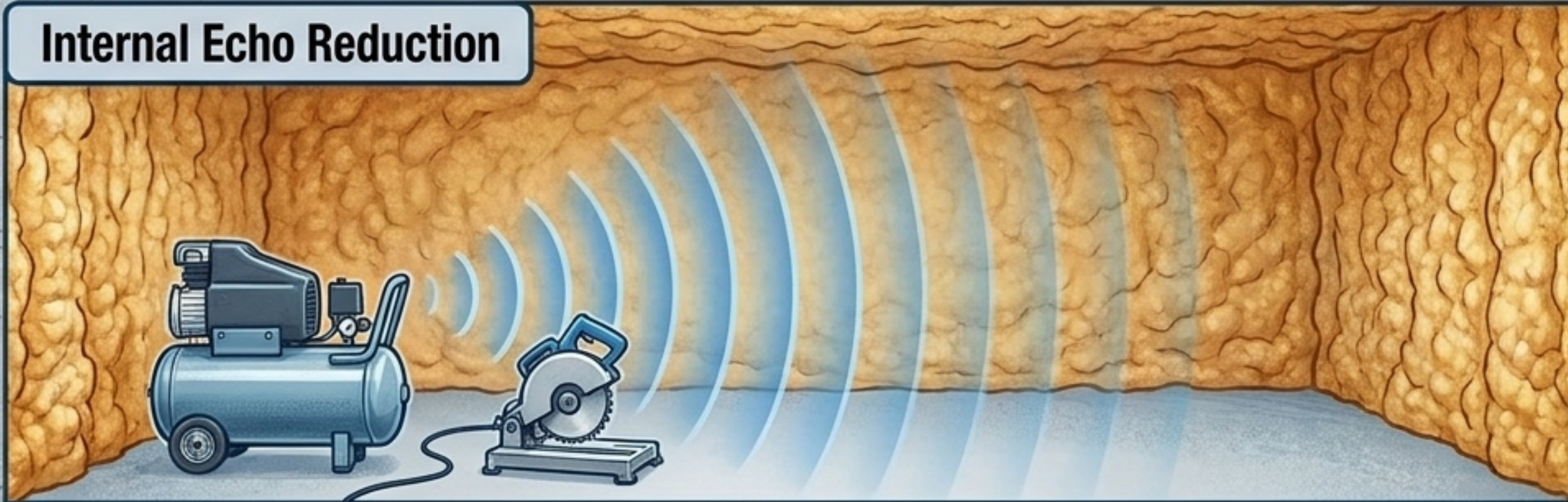
